### Briefing and Q&A

**Ian Sloyan of ISDA** will provide the members with an overview of the ISDA Common Domain Model (<u>CDM</u>), which has been developed as an industry solution to tackle the lack of standard conventions in how derivatives trade events and processes are represented, and how ICMA is cooperating with ISDA to extend this to include cash bonds and repo. The development of the CDM for all financial markets and securities is seen to be critical in creating cross-industry efficiencies while easing the development and adaptation of new technologies.

### 4. Consolidated tape for fixed income

### Briefing

Liz Callaghan of ICMA will update the group on the recent <u>response</u> of ICMA's MiFID II Data Workstream (involving the buy-side, sell-side, trading venues and data providers) to ESMA's consultation on cost of market data and consolidated tape. ICMA will also be meeting with the European Commission on September 26 to discuss next steps in the development of a fixed income consolidate tape.
